

Request for Approval of Honors Graduation Unit

As described in the catalog and at <http://www.math.rutgers.edu/undergrad/honors/hongrad.html>, the requirements for graduating with mathematics department honors include the completion of two honors units. Each of the courses 411, 412, 451, and 452 for which the student has received at least a grade of B counts as an honors unit. There are three alternative forms of honors units:

- (a) An approved mathematics **graduate course**.
- (b) An approved **independent study course**. This may be a reading course or research project.
- (c) An approved **special project** supplementing a mathematics course at the 300-400 level.

Each of these alternative honors units requires approval of the honors committee. The purpose of this form is to apply for this approval. This form should normally be submitted by the beginning of the semester during which the work is to be done.
