a) 
$$\sum_{n=0}^{\infty} \frac{nx^n}{n^2 + 1}$$

b) 
$$\sum_{n=1}^{\infty} \frac{n^2(x-1)^n}{2^n}$$

c) 
$$\sum_{n=1}^{\infty} \frac{3^n x^n}{n^2}$$
